Yesterday, Classes 2 & 3 went to Locomotion in Shildon. First, we put our coats and bags away. Then our tour guides - Tom and Darren - showed us round an old steam train and how it works. It was interesting to find the difference between a steam train and a modern electric train. Our tour guides showed us one of the first steam trains and it was built by a local man called Timothy Hackworth. Unfortunately, the train didn't work but Timothy was a local hero but he still gets called the 'What if' man. After looking at the trains we learnt about circuits and built our own mini, electric, racing cars. Once we had had lunch, we went to see Tim Peake's Soyuz rocket return capsule and it was interesting because it had so many buttons but it was really small. We met a man who told us about the International Space Station and what Tim Peake did in space. He told us about



how the return capsule came back and how it was designed. When it landed, after it had been travelling at 27,000km per hour, three small parachutes deployed followed by a larger one which was the size of 2 tennis courts. One metre from the ground, 6 rockets fired to slow it down to 5km per hour before landing.

Everyone has learned a lot about trains and Tim Peake's time in the International Space Station.
