Activity - To learn how to step out a story

Phonics

Group 1

Phonic Fun - Bring phonics outdoors and children can decorate letters with shells, small pebbles or petals. Practise letter formation by chalking on different surfaces.

Spray Painting - Use spray bottles to spray over chalk letters. Squeezing the handle of the spray bottle strengthens the muscles in the hands.

Group 2 - Worksheets attached to consolidate sounds 'ng' and writing 'at' to complete sentences.

Group 3 - Worksheets to consolidate 'igh' and 'oo' sounds

Group 4 - Worksheets to consolidate 'i-e' and 'o-e' sounds
