Due to such a huge invasion of rabbits on our school field the Class 1 area is the only area apart from a fenced off garden area on the field which is safe from rabbits! The children in Class 1 have started to re-pot the plants and we look forward to growing different types of herbs, rhubarb and other edible plants.
