## Class 2

It's been an exciting and Christmassy week here in Class 2.

We have been solving Christmas mysteries using our maths skills and writing character descriptions of one Ebenezer Scrooge! We also enjoyed our delicious Christmas lunch on Tuesday – Thanks Barbara!

We have also been investigating a festive text called *One Christmas Wish*.

On Thursday morning we did a *Fit for Life* session where we practised our squats and lifting techniques.

We have also been working hard putting the finishing touches to our Christmas play and practising for our Christingle celebration next week. Phew!

## Class 3

In Numeracy this week we have focused on mastering the skill of multiplying a 2-digit number by 2 digits before moving onto a 3-digit number by 2 digits. As part of this, Class 3 completed a variety of problem solving and reasoning challenges involving missing numbers, find the errors and some tricky problems where Class 3 needed to work out two 2-digit numbers that would multiply together to give a specific number e.g. between 500 and 600 but it also must be even! These problems really showed how Class 3 had mastered the skill of multiplication and showed their incredible resilience.

In Literacy we have moved onto a Christmas themed unit. We watched the 2021 Kevin the Carrot advert and focused on ordering the story and writing our version using different sentence openers and interesting details. We then focused on some of the puns from the advert and wrote some of our own to see who had the 'punniest'.

We did our first rehearsal for our Nativity in the Village Hall this week and we can't wait for Tuesday to show everyone! 😊
