# Class 1 and 'Little Learners'

## **Little Learners**

We have had a busy few weeks at school since the half term break!

We started off celebrating Hallowe'en, followed closely by Bonfire Night.

The children really enjoyed making their own pretend bonfire on the field and produced some wonderful firework pictures!

Last week, we remembered the soldiers past and present and painted some beautiful hand print poppies.

This week, we have been working from the story 'What the Ladybird heard'. The children have enjoyed using some peg dolls to join in with the story and retell it in their own words.

We have started our new topic, 'On the Farm' and the EYFS children have had fun creating their own toy farm in a tuff tray. 2






















## Class 1

In maths, Year 2 have been continuing addition and subtraction. We have been using a variety of resources to support our learning including bar 10, tens frames and counters and number lines. 2

Reception have been representing 5, showing speedy fingers to represent 5, counting 1-1 objects, saying one number at a time and counting larger objects indoors and outdoors.

In literacy, Year 2 have been extending sentences using 'and', 'or' and 'but' to add description (coordination), extending sentences in stories to add description and using subordinating conjunctions to add subordinate clauses.

Reception have been reading the stories of 'The Three Little Pigs' and 'The Billy Goats Gruff'. They have been retelling the stories, creating story maps, role-playing the stories and writing simple labels and posters.

In geography, Year 2 have started learning about our corner of the world. We have been using Google Earth to locate where we are in the North East, where Cotherstone is and our own homes.

In PE, we have been producing our own cat dance in small groups. Initially we watched some videos to see how cats move. We then listed their actions and we have now chosen some moves to put into a sequence for a dance. The children have really enjoyed this, and we look forward to performing the dance to the older children in a few weeks' time!

In design and technology we have been learning how wheels work, making a moving vehicle and fixing broken wheels.

In PSHE we have been focusing on anti-bullying this week by completing a range of activities.
