## This week in Class 3

This week Class 3 have been mastering the skill of adding and subtracting. To do this they have worked through a variety of problem solving and reasoning questions such as missing number work and 'Be the Teacher' activities. As always, they have approached their mastery work with enthusiasm and resilience, working through tricky problems and challenging themselves.

In Class 3 we have daily reading lessons where children focus on one of our VIPERS reading skills. This week has been an Anglo-Saxon themed week and we have read extracts from a text called Anglo-Saxon boy. Class 3 used retrieval skills to answer questions about the text.

As part of our science topic, 'Living Things and Their Habitats', children classified leaves, thinking about their characteristics. They sorted them into groups thinking about if they were simple or compound, linear, roundish, needle-like or lobed. We went outside to the front of the school and then to explore the field searching for a variety of trees before collecting the leaf samples to classify indoors.

We have been learning how to play the glockenspiel in music, exploring 'Scratch' in computing to create an animated game and learning how to create a portrait in art.
