Class 3

This week in Class 3 we have been very busy writing a new chapter for our class text, The Malamander. They have been learning how to use relative clauses within their writing to add detail.

We learnt how 'The Eerie Book Dispensary', which is a book shop like no other, can be seen into at night and the things in there are not what you would expect in a bookshop. Class 3 wrote about the mini worlds within, where characters from books climb out and come to life!

In maths this week we have been developing our mastery of fractions. We have found equivalent fractions, converted mixed numbers to improper fractions and vice versa and worked on our addition and subtraction of fractions. Class 3 have once again showcased their ability to problem solve and reason when exploring fractions.

We have developed our art skills using mixed-media to create a final piece of artwork. Class 3 experimented with different ways of using mixed-media on their portraits, before creating a final piece incorporating their favourite techniques. They produced some excellent artwork as you can see!


In history we have been exploring The Maya by making comparisions between them and the Vikings to see who we believe was more successful. To do this we carried out some research into their achievements and explored these before using drama to act out a scene in role explaining why they believe they were more successful. We found out that The Vikings had excellent trade links, invented the comb and built longboats, whereas The Maya were highly advanced in art, writing and mathematics.

We explored what friction is in science by trying to pick up jelly with and without oil on using chopsticks to draw conclusions. Then we investigated the question: 'Whose shoe has the most friction?' using newton meters to measure the force.



































Awards
