This week's overall attendance is 89.2%. Class 2 had the best attendance with 91.4%.

This week in Class 2

We've had an excellent start to the Spring Term in Class 2, it has been incredible to reflect on the progress the children have made following their first term in Year 3 and 4.

In literacy, we have been working on writing a non-chronological report linked to our history topic, Ancient Greece. We have done lots of work on the organisational features like the heading, introduction and sub-headings and the SPAG features; present perfect tense, commas in a list, subordinating conjunctions and expanded noun phrases ready for writing our reports.

We have been mastering our multiplication and division skills in maths with lots of times tables practice.

In history, we have been archaeologists exploring what life was like in Early Greece using artefacts.

As part of our 'Rocks and Soils' topic in science, we have been investigating the layers of the earth. To do this, we created an 'edible' version showing the inner and outer core, the mantle, crust and then the layers of soil up to the topsoil we can see. Class 2 then enjoyed creating some fold down books to showcase their learning about the layers.

We've enjoyed the outdoors, where possible around this stormy weather, to enjoy forest school with Miss Lee and taking part in the Big School Bird Watch with our wonderful visitors from the Tees-Swale AONB. In the first session, Class 2 created some natural bird feeders to place in the school grounds, before observing the birds in our school environment in the second session.
